Cigar accessories, hand-crafted humidors, imported pipes, tobaccos and cigar-theme golfing items are also found throughout the shop. The main feature, however, is a cigar lounge with a coffee bar, leather chairs, a chess table, a TV and a selec-

tion of newspapers.
"We want people to feel free to stop by and just relax," Sudar said.


